
Marechal Deodoro da Fonseca



Marechal Deodoro da Fonseca

Deodoro was a marshal in the Army. For most of his life he supported the monarchy, but in 1889 he led the military movement that removed Emperor Dom Pedro II from power.

His respect among the officers helped give legitimacy to the coup. Later, he became the first president of Brazil, starting the republican system.

Dom Pedro II



Dom Pedro II

The last emperor of Brazil, he ruled for almost 50 years. He was respected abroad and seen as a cultured and progressive leader. But by the end of his reign, he faced strong opposition:

Unhappy military officers, landowners who lost power after the end of slavery, and republicans who wanted a new government system. After the Proclamation of the Republic, he was removed from power and went into exile in Europe.

Dom Pedro II

TDaughter of Dom Pedro II, she ruled as regent when her father was absent. Her most important act was signing the Golden Law in 1888, which ended slavery in Brazil.

She was not directly part of the Proclamation of the Republic, but her decision created anger among slave owners, who stopped supporting the monarchy. Because of this, Isabel is seen as part of the context that weakened the Empire.



Rui Barbosa

A lawyer, politician, and intellectual, he was a strong supporter of republican ideas. He helped create the legal and political arguments that defended the change of regime.

He became one of the most important voices of the republican movement and was later called the "Eagle of The Hague" for his work abroad.

Floriano Peixoto



Floriano Peixoto

A military officer and close ally of Deodoro, he strongly supported the end of the monarchy.

After Deodoro resigned, Floriano became the second president of Brazil. He helped strengthen the Republic and became known as the "Iron Marshal" because of his strict style of leadership.
